

HOW TO MAKE AN EGG-TIMER 360° TIME-LAPSE THINGY!

Right, here we go. Take one tripod quick-release base plate (manfrotto pictured) take out the screw and stick that (using a cement glue) to the top of an egg-timer. Stick the bottom of the plate to the bottom of the egg-timer and that's it. The egg timer goes onto a tripod and the GoPro (you will need the GoPro tripod adapter) on top of the timer. Even for a below average DIYer it is a piece of piss! And finally, hide it from the client as it doesn't look very impressive but the results are brilliant.

Set the time-lapse function of the GoPro to take a picture every 10 seconds, twist egg-timer to 60 minutes and get out of the way. Import into QuickTime Player 7 as a sequence at 25fps.
